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Grant of grade pay of Rs.4600 instead of Rs.4200 Pre-2006 Grade S-12 pensioners retired from the 5<sup>th</sup> CPC pay scale of Rs.6500-200-10500, IV CPC pay scales of Rs.2000-60-2300-75-3200 & Rs.2000-60-2300-75-3200-100-3500 or in the corresponding pay scales under earlier pay commissions —implementation of DoP&PW OM dated 4-1-2019 and 9-7-2019 issued consequent upon revision of grade pay from Rs.4200 to Rs.4600 without calling for particulars from Pension Sanctioning Authorities

Some of the Pension Accounting Offices (PAOs) and GMs (Postal Accounts and Finance)/ Director of Accounts (Postal) and CCAs reportedly, are calling for particulars of notional pay from the Heads of Offices (HOO)/ Pension Sanctioning Authorities (PSA) to enable them to issue revised PPOs in implementation of the OMs dated 4.1.2019 and 9.7.2019 issued by DoP&PW consequent upon increase in grade pay of grade S-12 retirees from Rs.4200 to Rs.4600 under the 6th CPC w.e.f 1.1.2006.

2. The PAOs have reportedly, requested the PSAs to furnish particulars of the affected Pensioners in a prescribed proforma with details such as the name of the Pensioner, date of retirement, pay scale from which the Pensioner had retired, last pay drawn, Notional pay under 7<sup>th</sup> CPC etc., for issuance of revised PPOs by them in implementation of DOP&PW OMs dated 4.1.2019 and 9.7.2019.

3. There seems to be no need to call for such particulars from the HOO/ PSAs since all the relevant details required for revision of pension

of pre 2016 grade S-12 retirees are already available with the concerned PAOs which were obtained by them from the respective HOO/ PSA for revision of pension in terms of para No.4 of DoP&PW OM dated 12.5.2017 issued in implementation of Option -1 recommended by the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC.

4. Pension of all pre 2016 Pensioners was revised previously by the PAOs only after the concerned HOO/PSA had fixed the notional pay of the pensioner under 7th CPC as required vide para 18 of DoP&PW OM dated 12.5.17 and had furnished the details such as the Pay scale from which the Pensioner had retired, the last pay drawn, and its subsequent revision under subsequent pay commissions and the notional pay under 7th CPC for computation pension and family pension.

5. Therefore, in respect of those Pensioners for whom the PAOs had already issued revised PPOs as per DoP&PW OM dated 12.5.2017, there is no need to call for any additional details from the PSAs/ HOOs and the PAOs can straight away revise the pension of pre-2016 grade S-12 retirees in accordance with the instructions contained in DoP&PW OM dated 4.1.2019 and 9.7.2019 with reference to the revised concordance tables annexed thereto issued by DoP&PW after revision of grade pay of grade S-12 retirees from Rs.4200 to Rs.4600.

6. It must be noted that the particulars required for implementation of DoP&PW OM dated 9.7.2019 are only the **pay scale from which** 

the pensioner had retired and the last pay drawn and those details are already available with the PAOs which were furnished by the HOOs/ PSAs for revision of pension in terms of DoP&PW OM dated 12.5.2017.

7. The revised pension and family pension admissible to grade S-12 retirees from 1-1-2006 after increase of grade pay from Rs.4200 to Rs.4600 are available in the statement annexed to DoP&PW OM dated 4-1-2009 and the revised notional pay under 7<sup>th</sup> CPC, revised pension and family pension admissible from 1-1-2016 have been indicated in the revised tables NOs 24 & 25 annexed to OM 9.7.2019 and therefore, the PAOs can straight away fix the revised pension/family pension to which the pensioner/family pensioner is entitled to with reference to the **last pay drawn, the particulars of which are already available with the PAOs.** 

8. Calling for the same particulars again from PSAs/ HOOs not only results in delay in implementation of DoP&PW OM dated 4.1.2019 and 9.7.2019 but also in making the concerned offices to attend to avoidable work and correspondence

9. Hence, it is requested that necessary instructions may please be caused to be issued by DoP&PW early to all authorities concerned to impress upon the PAOs to issue revised PPOs immediately without waiting / calling for any further information from the PSAs/ HOOs

# No referral required for treatment from Government Hospitals

With reference to the above mentioned subject it is clarified that no permission is required for OPD consultation / treatment from any of the Government Hospitals including Govt. Ayush hospitals and medicines shall be issued by CGHS Wellness Centres.

Additional Directors of CGHS Cities / Zones shall issue instructions accordingly to the Medical Officers, CGHS working under the administrative control of the concerned Addl Director.

Pendency of Medical Claims of CGHS Pensioner beneficiaries due to deficiency in documentation (More Documents Required)

The matter concerning pendency of Medical Claims of CGHS pensioner beneficiaries has been reviewed in this Directorate and the undersigned is directed to state that it is now decided that the following revised guidelines shall be followed in respect of such medical claims:

1. The medical claims, which are incomplete in documentation shall be examined to see if there are any minor deficiencies, which can be resolved to process the claims by Addl. Directors. These include:

- i) **Photocopy of CGHS Card and validity** Addl. Director, CGHS, may try if, the matter can be verified from CGHS data base.
- ii) Emergency Certificate is not sacrosanct and from the clinical findings in the discharge summary the emergency factor can be ascertained. Even powers are vested with ADs to consider ex-post fact approval at CGHS rates even under non emergency conditions using the powers for condonation of procedural lapses.
- iii) Some cities ask for Bed-Ticket issued at Hospital – these are not mentioned in the CGHS Check list and the beneficiary shall not be asked to submit the same
- iv) If empanelled hospital has not provided credit facility and the pensioner has made payment, often the beneficiary is asked to explain as to why the hospital

has not provided credit facility. Such practice shall be avoided and explanation if any shall be called for from empanelled hospital.


v) In case of Chemotherapy, there is option to collect chemotherapy medicines from CGHS before undergoing Injection/ Infusion from empanelled hospital. However, it is not compulsory and as per the policy of hospitals, particularly JCM accredited hospitals, and some of the NABH Accredited hospitals, they shall not accept medicines from outside hospital supplies. In such cases, the processing of the claims shall not be delayed unnecessarily on this ground.

2. Despite the steps undertaken as mentioned above under Para (1), if some deficiencies still persist in documentation, Addl. Director, CGHS shall send a letter to the beneficiary by speedpost clearly indicating the requisite documents within Five working days of receipt of claim papers at the office of Addl.Director, CGHS. The beneficiary shall also be informed by telephone / e-mail to submit the same to the Office of Additional Director, CGHS.

3. As per the existing guidelines, the medical claims of beneficiaries aged 80 years and above shall be processed on priority out of turn.

CMOs i/c or a person nominated by CMO i/c may be given training at the office of Addl. Director regarding verification of documentation before accepting the same at the CGHS Wellness Centre.

# Grant of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners/ family pensioners - Revised rate effective from 01.07.2019

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The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No. 42/04/2019-P&PW(D) dated 06.03.2019 on the subject mentioned above and to state that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief admissible to Central Government pensioners/ family pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 12% to 17% w.e.f 01.07.2019.

2. These rates of DR will be applicable to (i) **Civilian Central Government Pensioners/Family** Pensioners including Central Govt. absorbee pensioners in PSU/ Autonomous Bodies in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 4/34/2002-P&PW(D) Vol.11 dated 23.06.2017 for restoration of full pension after expiry of commutation period of 15 years (ii) The Armed Forces Pensioners, Civilian Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates, (iii) All India Service Pensioners (iv) Railway Pensioners/family pensioners (v) Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension (vi) The Burma Civilian pensioners/family pensioners and pensioners/ families of displaced Government Pensioners from Burma/ Pakistan, in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 23/3/2008-P&PW(B) dated 11.09.2017.

3. The payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

4. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and reemployed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in this Department's OM No. 45/73/ 97-P&PW (G) dated 2.7.1999 as amended vide this Department's OM No. F.No. 38/88/ 2008-P&PW(G) dated 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2009. The provisions relating to regulation of DR where

a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.

5. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately

6. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of DR payable in each individual case.

7. The offices of Accountant General and authorised Pension Disbursing Banks are requested to arrange payment of relief to pensioners etc. on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of letter No. 528-TA, ii/34-80-II dated 23/04/1981 of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No. GANB No. 2958/GA-64 (ii) (CGL)/81 dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its subsidiaries and all Nationalised Banks.

8. In their application to the pensioners/family pensioners belonging to Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders issue after consultation with the C&AG.

9. This issues in accordance with Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's OM No. 1/3/2019-E.II(B) dated 14th October, 2019.

# Emergency treatment in CGHS empanelled Hospitals.

The extant instructions under CGHS provide that under emergency conditions, a CGHS beneficiary can get admission in any CGHS empanelled Hospital without any prior permission. It has, however, been brought to the notice that the Hospitals deny admission or insist on referral memo from CGHS Wellness Centre even in emergency conditions.

2. In accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement between the CGHS empanelled Hospital and the Government of India, refusal to provide treatment to bonafide CGHS beneficiaries in emergency cases and other eligible categories of beneficiaries on credit basis, without valid ground, would attract disqualification for continuation of empanelment.

3. It is, therefore, reiterated that in emergency the empanelled hospitals will not refuse admission or demand an advance payment from the CGHS beneficiary or his family member and will provide credit facilities to the patient.
